From Pastor Bruce A Little Child Shall Lead

Speaking on the birth of the Christ Child, the prophet Isaiah said, "The wolf shall dwell with the lamb and the leopard shall lie down with the kid, and the calf and the lion and the fatling together, and a little child shall lead them."

In preparing to celebrate such a special birth we realize that facts and figures don't help us much in this season of angels and miracles. This is the time of love beyond reason; of hope without boundaries. Instead of speaking in prose, Christmas is for poetry. Every December I remember the words of Madeline L'Engle:

This is the irrational season when love blooms bright and wild. Had Mary been filled with reason there'd have been no room for the child.

He came in a time when the key words were politics and economics. He came when there was a great desire for military might and a military leader. He came in a time not so very different from our own. The baby came and then they remembered Isaiah, "The wolf shall dwell with the lamb... and a little child shall lead them."

Carl Sandburg said, "A baby is God's opinion that the world should go on." This baby is God's promise that it will - if we will follow. Jesus is the one child who can free all of God's children from their suffering and sin. He is the one who makes his way along the murky path of human existence and emerges shining, even more brightly than the star that takes us to him - if we will follow.


